Green Valley High School Collaboration MOU

June 4, 2023

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into by and between the Yucaipa-Calimesa Joint Unified School District (“District”) and the Yucaipa-Calimesa Educators Association/CTA/NEA (“Association”). Both parties agree that the following will be in effect for the 2023-2024 school year and is non-precedent setting.

Article 6: Hours

6.1 Unit members who work less than an eight (8) hours day as set per contract shall be on campus and responsible for instruction and other assigned duties for fifteen (15) minutes prior to the beginning of the first regular instructional period of the day. Unit members shall be on campus and responsible for instructional and other assigned duties during these periods. The fifteen (15) minutes before school for Green Valley High teachers shall be set aside for conferences and preparation, with teachers reporting to the classroom in sufficient time for students to be able to enter the classroom and be ready for classroom instruction to begin at the tardy bell. All other provisions of Article 6.1 will remain in effect.

6.1.2 The length of the instructional day for unit members shall be tentatively modified as follows with all other provisions of Article 6.1.2 remaining in effect:

All Grades	282 minutes (full day)
	210 minutes (minimum day)

6.9.4. Since Green Valley High operates on a quarter system, Article 6.9.4 shall be modified so that the following six minimum days during the 2023-2024 school year shall be provided for end-of-quarter assessment. The purpose of these days is to support teachers’ use of performance-based assessment. Unit members may leave fifteen (15) minutes after the last scheduled class period on these days.

- Friday, October 6, 2023
- Wednesday, December 13, 2023
- Thursday, December 14, 2023
- Friday, March 8, 2024
- Monday, June 3, 2024
- Tuesday, June 4, 2024

On regular school days, all teachers will receive a forty-seven (47) minute conference period and a forty-three (43) minute collaboration time. On collaboration minimum days, all teachers will receive a thirty-five (35) minute conference period, a thirty-five (35) minute collaboration time, and an eighty (80) minute additional collaboration time.

Green Valley High will have a minimum day every Friday school is in session. On collaboration minimum days, the thirty-three (33) collaboration days will be scheduled as follows:

100% Teacher-Directed Fridays

- Friday, October 6, 2023, will be designated a minimum day for assessment.
- Friday, March 8, 2024, will be designated a minimum day for assessment.
- Friday, May 31, 2024, will be split equally, with the first sixty (60) minutes under the direction of the principal and the last sixty (60) minutes under the direction of the site’s teachers.

Friday Minimum Day Collaboration time will begin four (4) minutes after students are dismissed and will conclude after eighty (80) minutes have passed.

- Fifty percent (50%) of the time will be used for teacher-directed research, practitioner inquiry, data analysis, instructional planning, and/or professional development under the direction of teachers. –Further, this teacher-directed collaboration will be pre-planned, follow established norms, and be reported on by grade-level teams, other vertically configured teams, or the entire faculty. This time is in addition to the preparation time in Article 6.1.2.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the time will be pre-planned and used for research, practitioner inquiry, data analysis, instructional planning, staff/faculty meetings, and/or professional development, under the direction of the principal (or designee). The site's staff/faculty meeting will not be held before or after school, but other professional responsibilities that take place outside the workday (as noted in Article 6.1) remain in place.

Analysis of CFA data will be split evenly between the teacher-directed and principal-directed time.

The District and the Association agree that there will be no adjustments to teacher compensation based on the instructional minutes outlined in this MOU.
